

# Scholarships and Aids

Meritorious and poor students are granted half-fee concession/full fee concession. They may apply for it as notified by the college authorities and by the given date. Up to a maximum of 10% of the total strength of the students on roll are eligible to be granted such benefits as per norms. Principal can also help the needy students from the Student Aid Fund.
